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Background Of Establishment Of National Housing Authority (NHA)

The end of the British rule and the partition of the subcontinent resulted in migration of millions of Muslim refugees from India to the main towns of present Bangladesh. To rehabilitate these refugees the then Government of Pakistan created housing wing under the Ministry of Power and Irrigation, in 1958, and had taken organized housing programs throughout the country for the refugees as well as for local low and middle income families. In 1971, after successful completion of the refugee rehabilitation program, the housing wing was upgraded to Housing and Settlement directorate. In 2001, by a statutory law, it was enacted as the National Housing Authority (NHA) as an Autonomous body under the Ministry of Housing & Public works.

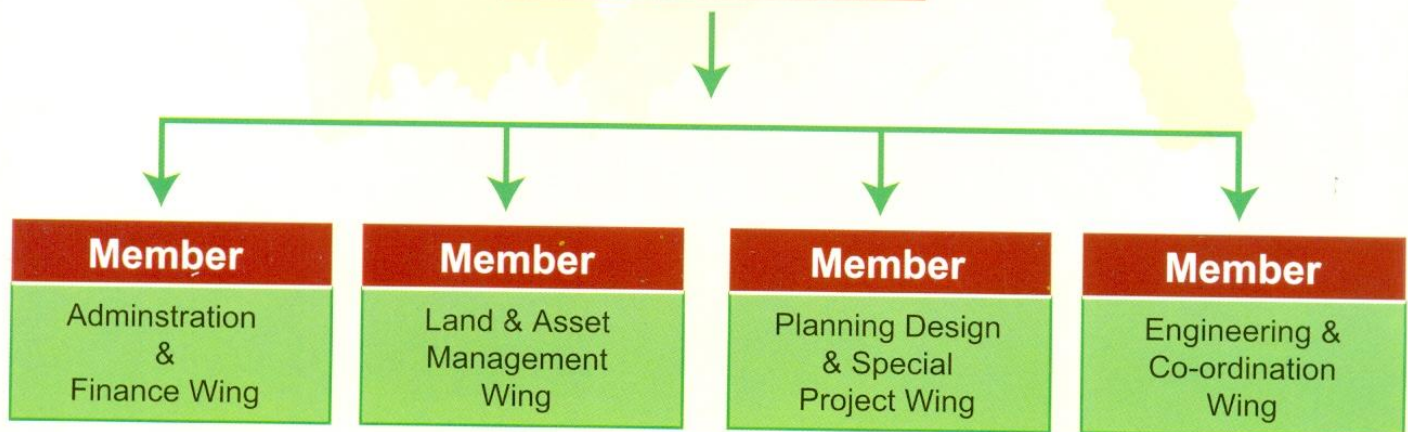
Rationale Of NHA

Bangladesh is one of the most densely populated developing countries in the world. Its total population is over 140 million, out of which 25% is living in urban areas. Urban people are scattered in 6 divisions, 64 districts and 481 upazilla headquarters. The rural people are living in 4500 unions and 68000 villages. The country is facing a shortage of affordable housing both in the urban and rural areas. Access to shelter or housing is difficult for the low and middle income groups of people and it is extremely acute for the poor. Unplanned housing in Urban and Rural areas requires more land and extends settlement in valuable productive agricultural land. Planned housing minimizes land requirement, provide more facilities /services and save agricultural land. It is the demand of the time to be selective to undertake plan for growing up an effective housing structure with the minimum land use. The Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh guarantees the citizens for shelter, which is a basic need. The present Government emphasizes on the national goals of Vision 2021, which includes "House for all by 2021" National housing Authority, as an institution, excels all its efforts to achieve these goal within the timeframe.

Overall objective of NHA is to solve the acute housing problem of the urban and rural areas of the country including the capital city.

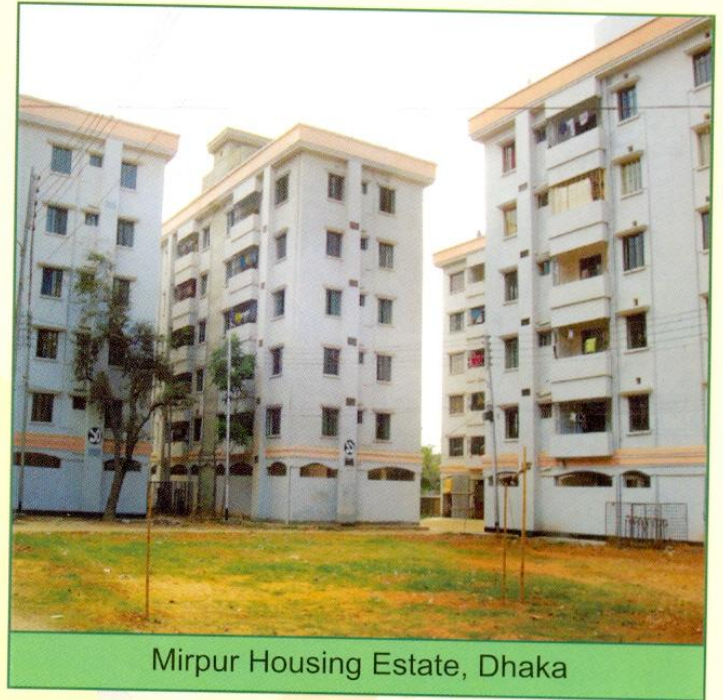
Functions

- Conduct survey and study, collect and preserve information regarding housing throughout the country.
- Further developing National Housing policies and presenting it to the Government for approval.
- Taking up low cost and self-help basis housing projects both in urban and rural areas subject to the approval of the government.
- Formulate housing program for natural disaster and emergency situation and its implementation
- Undertake housing program for destitute women, helpless people and for the poor.
- Construction of buildings, houses, apartments and flats on land owned by NHA and land handed over to it by the Government.
- Organize national and international conference, seminar, symposium and workshops regarding housing.
- Conduct research work on housing.
- Allotment of flats, plots etc. and execution of lease deed, permission for sale, mortgage, mutation and collection of rent, revenue and other charges.
- Development of urban centers at Upazilla level
- Attract foreign and local investment to implement housing projects
- Carryout any other activities necessary to facilitate the above functions.

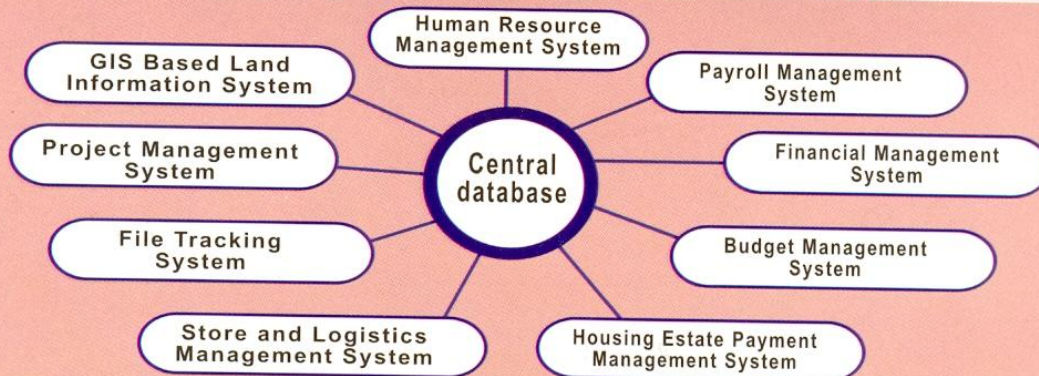

Automation of NHA management system



Human Resource Management (HRMS)

Efficient and effective management of Human Resource has progressed to an increasingly imperative and complex process. The HR function consists of tracking existing employee data which traditionally includes personal histories, skills, capabilities, accomplishments and salary. For an organization like NHA with 529 employees this is a huge task. To reduce the manual workload of these administrative activities and perform it more efficiently. NHA has automated this process by developing a specialized Human Resource Management Systems. The system records basic demographic and address data, training and efficiency, progress, capabilities and skill management, increment, posting and other related informations.

GIS based Land Record System (LRGIS)

To solve the enormous housing problem of the country, the National Housing Authority undertakes housing programs throughout the country. Traditionally, all records of each housing estate- such as plot and owner details, and project maps are kept in analogue hard copy format which is very difficult to manage, store, search and is susceptible to damage. Moreover, the citizens have limited or poor access to these information. To overcome all these problems and to give better services to the citizens, NHA has recently developed a GIS and web based Land Record System (LRGIS). For this system's input, the institute is currently, converting plot and owner details of all housing estates into digital format and the maps of the housing estates into digital GIS layers. This online system will enable the citizens to view the housing maps, plot location, plot details, number of owners of a plot, owner's details with photo, official details and present condition of the plot. This systems will let the NHA store and manage this ever growing information easily, efficiently and smartly, and allows clients to access this information quickly and efficiently. The owner of a plot of any housing estate can get his/her plot information on line by logging into the site and can generate a printable report which includes the owner's photo and the location map of the plot. Along with easy access to information, the system will also ensure security of ownership, which in turn, will reduce the disputes on land ownership.
